Time Commitment:

- The individual has to attend one Board meeting per month, and are expected to attend the Chapter's Evening and Community events and/or other events and meeting(s). Including these meetings and the addition of e-mails and telephone conversations, each prospective volunteer must be prepared to commit a minimum of **15-20 hours per month to Chapter meetings and activities.**
- This is a volunteer position and receives no paid compensation or reimbursement of out-of-pocket expenses for attendance at local board meetings. **You have to be an ASCM and Toronto Chapter Member in good standing.**

By signing this document, the individual agrees to:

- a) be available for a possible phone interview by the President,
- b) if requested, supply additional information and references,
- c) serve in accordance with the Chapter By-law,
- d) the time commitment and compensation guidelines outlined above. Board members may be asked to attend ASCM Meetings/Events and/or ASCM International Conference.
